



**TERMINATION IN THE ISSUANCE OF PROVISIONAL PERMIT (PROPER)/
TEMPORARY LESP OF PRIVATE SECURITY PERSONNEL**

(December 13, 2019)

- References:
 - RA 5487, as amended and its 2003 IRR;
 - Application for License to Exercise Security Profession (LESP) of Private Security Personnel (PSP); and
 - SOSIA memo dated August 18, 2017 re Issuance of Provisionary Permit (PROPER).
- Above references pertain to the issuance of Provisionary Permit or Temporary LESP by the various RCSUs to Private Security Personnel filing for new application or renewal of their respective LESP.
- Henceforth, issuance of said Provisional Permit shall cease immediately and advise applicant PSPs to file the renewal of their LESP within sixty (60) days prior to the expiration thereof (*Section 13. A, Rule V, 2003 IRR of RA 5487*). Any provisional permit in the hands of PSPs while on duty will not be honored and shall be considered as having no LESP at all and will be subjected to administrative sanctions as provided under Rule XVII of reference ia above.
- Those previously issued PROPER or temporary LESP shall cease/deemed invalid after thirty (30) days upon date of issuance.
- For strict compliance and widest dissemination.
